Dear People of St. Patrick Parish,

If we had been living in Jerusalem on the First Palm Sunday, would we have taken our family out into the streets to welcome Jesus to the Temple? Maybe, we face that same decision every Sunday and Holy Day.

If Jesus had invited us to the Last Supper to receive His Body and Blood in Holy Communion, would we have said no or it takes too much of my time? How about Mass and Communion every Sunday now.


