## Life at St. Patrick Parish

**Parish Maintenance -** Why do we need a monthly collection for Regular Parish Maintenance? On June 26, 2025, all the electrical system in the Church died. No lights, sounds etc. The Parish had to pay \$3,500.00 for a new main breaker, that is just the cost of the breaker, not including the installation fee. Total \$3,638.00.

**Bishop's Appeal** - When can we expect that St. Patrick Parish will reach its goal for the 2025 Bishop's Ministries Appeal and that each of us we'll have done our part. Take a look at the poster in the entrance to the Church. Let's get it done.

**Parish Diocesan Assessment** - On June 30th, we paid the Parish Diocesan Assessment for the second quarter, \$20,263.25, so far, we have paid \$40,526.50 and have two more quarter to go \$81,053.00 is the total for 2025.

**Deanery 7** - On Saturday, August 2, 2025, at St. Joseph Parish, Pinole, Deanery 7, which is the Deanery that we belong, will celebrate a Special Mass at 10:00am. Bishop Barber will celebrate the Mass along with our Deanery Priests. We want you to attend this Mass praying for our Jubilee Year 2025 as Pilgrims of Hope.
