

#### Welcome Back to School Summary

Saint Patrick School is open for the 2025-2026 school year. Here are a few highlights:

- We celebrated the start of the school year with mass and Open House – attendance was excellent and students and parents were excited to see their new teachers and classrooms.
- All grades are fully enrolled (although there are a few spaces in Kindergarten); preschool and infant care are full for an overall enrollment of 410 IC-8<sup>th</sup> grade students
- Four new teachers were hired (including parishioners and alumni) to replace a teacher who retired after 20 years of dedicated service, one who moved to Sacramento where she could afford a new home, and to free up our 2 administrators
- 100% of the K-8 "teaching" staff is Catholic (thanks to 2 baptisms this past year with Father Larry)
- In June, K-8 Teachers completed a 3 year training with LMU and are now Blended Learning Certified Teachers
- Teachers implemented a Virtues in Education program last year and scored #1 in Knowledge of Faith on the ARK test for the Diocese of Oakland
- The building project continues to progress with a current completion date of 6/2026
- Almost 80% of last year's 8<sup>th</sup> Grade graduating class are attending Catholic high schools in the area
