





Now we are planning on contracting with a professional cleaning service for weekly, thorough cleanings of the church. This is a great need, We are asking for new members to join and assist us so that we can better afford to keep up with some of the church needs, which helps with the church budget. Dues envelopes are available in the entry of the church and will serve as your application for membership and your name will be added to the roster so we can contact you.




