

A Message from our Pastor



Dear People of St. Patrick Parish,

Today, we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, and this concludes the Christmas celebration of the Church.

We just celebrated Jesus' Birth, the coming of the Shepherds and the Three Wise Men and now we look at Jesus 30 years old and preparing to spent three years, teaching, working miracles, founding the Catholic church and getting ready to be killed on the cross and to rise from the dead, to save all people who will allow Him to forgive them.

Between now and Wednesday, February 18th, Ash Wednesday, we will learn about His teachings and actions that will bring salvation to the whole world.

Santo Niño Celebration

The Feast of Santo Niño is celebrated on the Third Sunday in January.

In 1521, Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan planted the cross on the shores of Cebu, Philippines. Magellan gave the Holy Child statue as a gift to the ruler of the island. He and his wife were Baptized, and more than 800 natives were baptized in the Roman Catholic Church.

The image of Santo Niño de Cebu survived a fire that burnt down in coastal town in 1565.

St. Patrick Parish has two Santo Niño statues, and they remind us of our King and our God. We are reminded of the love and protection to the people of the Philippines by the prayer of Santo Niño. We pray today that all people of the Philippines will remain faithful to Santo Niño the suffering Christ and remember the love God shown to the people thru so many trials and persecutions.


