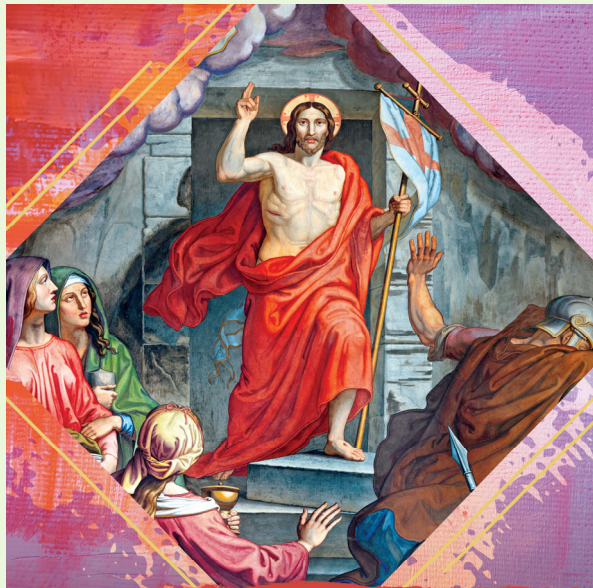

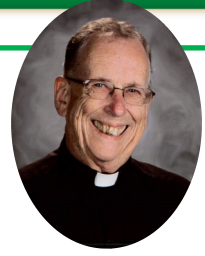

Rice Bowl - Place your Rice Bowls in the boxes near the Holy Water fonts. Thank you for helping those in great need.

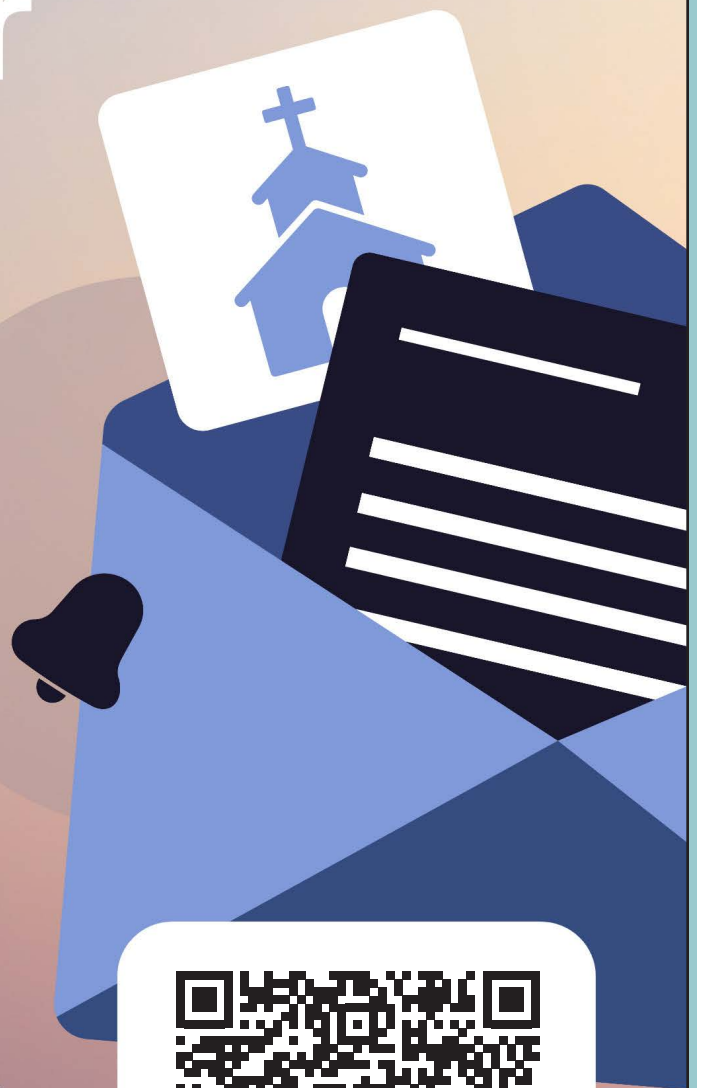
