

## A Message from our Pastor



Dear People of St. Patrick Parish,

Are we able to see God's love and care for the people He has given life to?

Today's first reading the Israelites pray to God to save them from their horrible life in Egypt, God sends Moses to lead them, they run out of food and water and they blame Moses, He is beside himself, but God tells him to strike rock and abundance water will come from the rock, only God can bring water out of a rock.

God sends His Son Jesus to die on the cross to save sinners who have disobeyed God and deserve to go to hell but out of His love for all people God lets Jesus die for all of us. 


