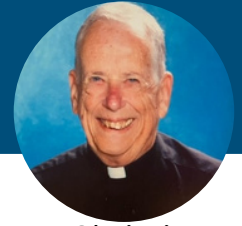

## TREE OF LIFE ROOTED IN HAPPY MEMORIES FOR ALL TIME

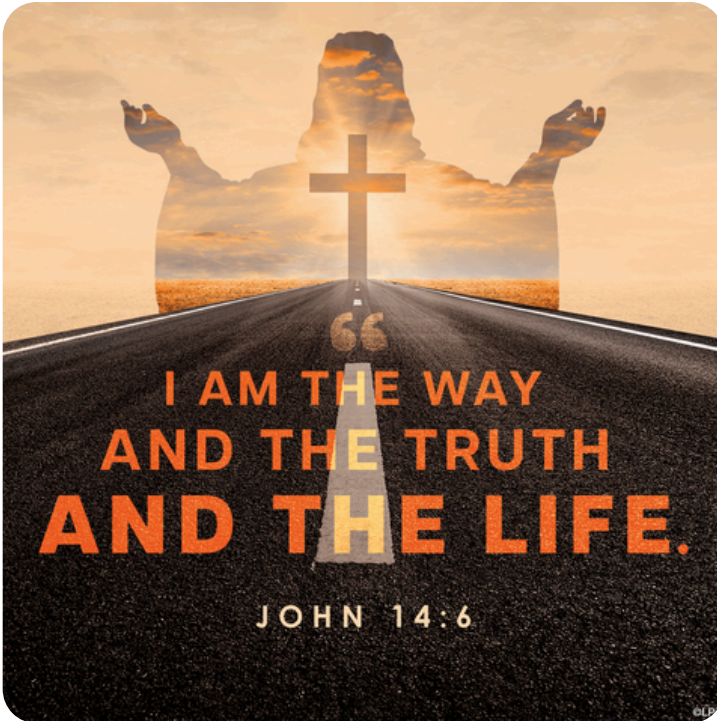

**FOOTNOTES**

The \$(16,034.55) deficit was mainly due to the shortfall of all income accounts except Sundays and Holiday collections plus Dinner Dance Fundraising along with the increase of Staff Expenses and prepayment of Insurance Expenses. Depreciation Expenses also added to the deficit but did not require cash payment.

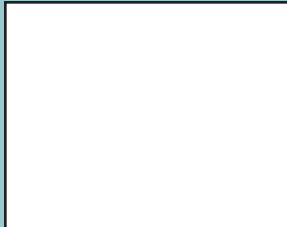

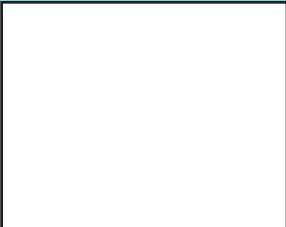

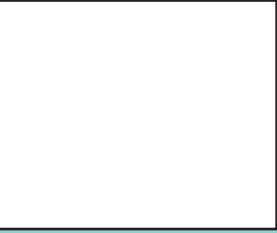
