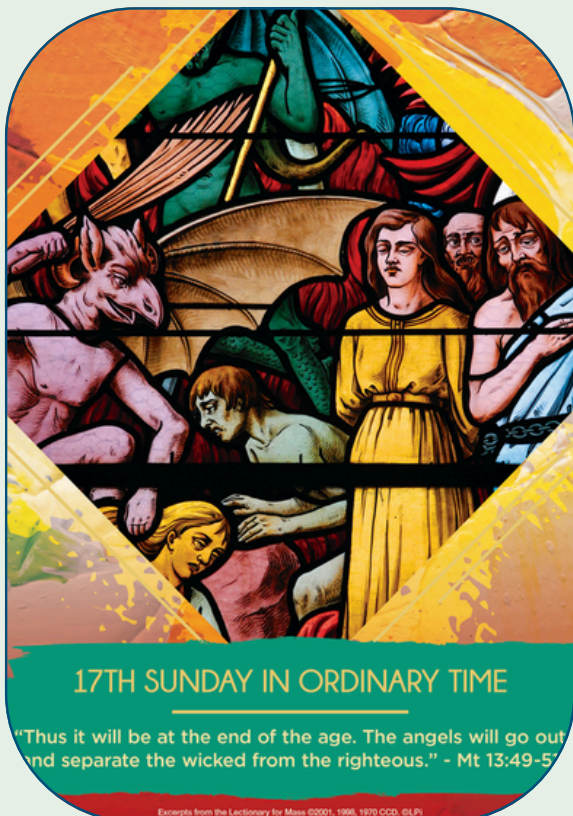

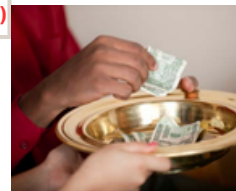

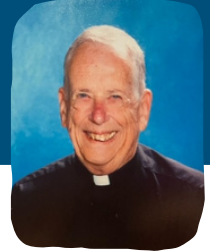

Footnote:

The deficit is largely due to the shortfalls of Revenue accounts, along with the increase in Insurance, Other Administrative Expenses, and Parish Property. Depreciation also added to the deficit but has no cash value.
